Standardised Price List - April 2026

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

Attended Funeral (Funeral Director's Charges Only) £2005

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.

This includes:

- Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements - £675
- Collection of Collection from place of death (home/hospital/care home) - from £150 (out of hours charges may apply) normally within 15 miles of the funeral directors premises.
- Care of the deceased prior to the funeral £450 (the deceased will be kept at the funeral directors premises at West View House, Easington Village)
- Providing a suitable coffin, this will be made of wood effect foil veneer- £375
- Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director, where viewing is required by the family from £5 (weekend and evening extra charges apply).
- At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed Cemetery or Crematorium. (Normally within 20 miles of the funeral directors premises in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle). From £350 restrictions apply.

Please note: Restrictions apply to our standardised funeral fees. The committal must take place at the same venue, and the coffin type cannot be changed or upgraded. This package is a very **basic funeral service** and does not allow additions, amendments, or reductions.

Unattended Funeral – Cremation (Funeral Directors Charges Only)

Cremation (Funeral Director Charges Only) - from £1415 plus crematorium fees.

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they **do not attend** the burial or cremation. ([Please see our dedicated direct cremations page for inclusions in our direct cremations package](#)).

Unattended Funeral – Burial - Burial unattended (Funeral Directors Charges Only) - from £1500 (depending on location)

Fees You Must Pay (Disbursements)

For cremation:

- The typical cost for an attended cremation funeral at Durham Crematorium is **£1,041**. Reduced fee services are available at **9:00am and 9:30am for £836**, while **Saturday morning cremations are £1,295**. **Direct cremation fees start from £535**, with restricted times applying (funeral directors choice of time). Please discuss any specific religious, belief-based and/or cultural requirements that you have with the funeral director.

For burial

For an attended or unattended burial funeral, the burial fee Peterlee Cemetery Eden Lane in this local area, **the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents are on the page below:**

For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot. An existing grave with a memorial in place you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees including out of area fees.
